

## Tuition & Scholarships

### **Student Tuition includes:**

Five (5) private lessons, piano accompanist, lectures, masterclasses, recitals, practice facilities, seminars, instrument technology program, outings and social events. Additionally, tuition includes housing at the Melrose Student Suites, and three meals per day.

Students are responsible for providing their own transportation to and from Jacksonville. Students traveling through Jacksonville International Airport will have opportunity to ride pre-arranged Buffet Crampon USA shuttles (schedule to be announced after student travel plans are completed).

### **Tuition: \$1,500**

Housing security deposit: \$100 (refundable)

Tuition and housing security deposit are due in full by July 15, 2008

All fees must be payable in U.S. funds drawn on a U.S. bank only. All checks should be payable to: *Buffet Crampon USA, Inc.* Once tuition has been submitted, all monies are nonrefundable.

### **Auditor Tuition includes:**

Attendance and observation of academy events including lectures, masterclasses, recitals, and seminars.

Auditors will not perform and will not receive or audit private lessons.

Auditors will be responsible for their own housing and meals.

Auditors may attend a one single session or several sessions during the week. A session is considered one full day. Sessions begin at 10:00 a.m. and end after the 7:00 p.m. recital at approximately 9:00 p.m. There is no recital scheduled for Monday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. The Monday session will end at approximately 5:00 p.m.

Tuition: **\$100 per session, per day**

Discount: A \$100 discount will be given for a full week of sessions (5)

Tuition is due in full by July 15, 2008

All fees must be payable in U.S. funds drawn on a U.S. bank only. All checks should be payable to: *Buffet Crampon USA, Inc.* Once tuition has been submitted, all monies are nonrefundable.

### **Scholarships:**

At the conclusion of the Academy, one student will be selected by the Artist Faculty for a full scholarship (\$1,500). This scholarship award will be based upon level of technical proficiency and musical artistry demonstrated during the Academy. The scholarship will be awarded at the closing recital on Saturday, August 9<sup>th</sup>.

Partial tuition scholarships will be awarded based on quality of application materials. Recipients will be notified upon acceptance to the Academy.
